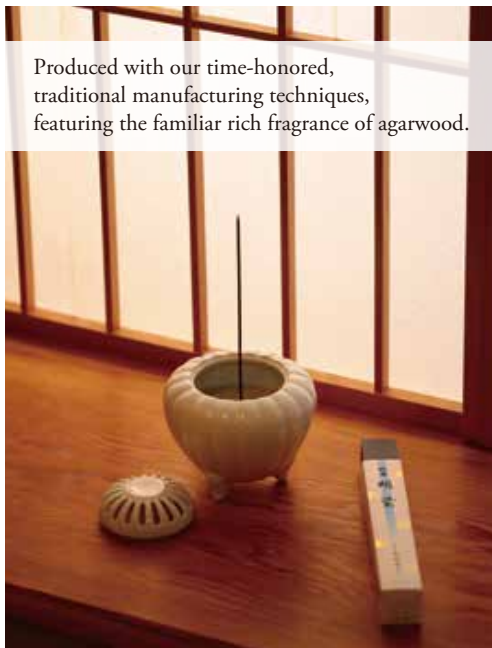

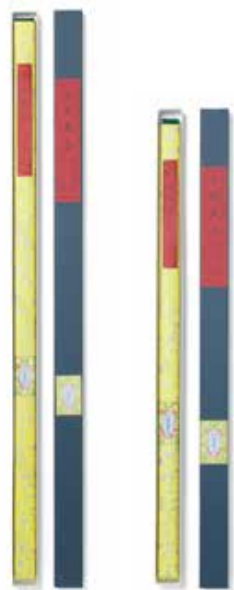

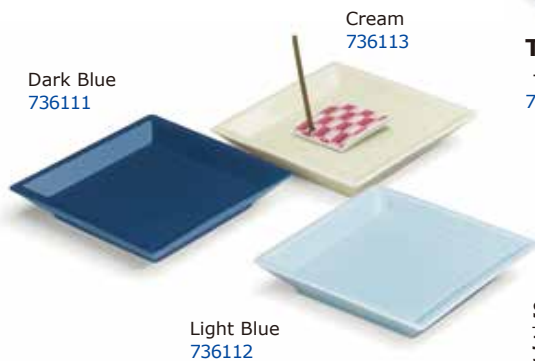

How to use Incense Censer

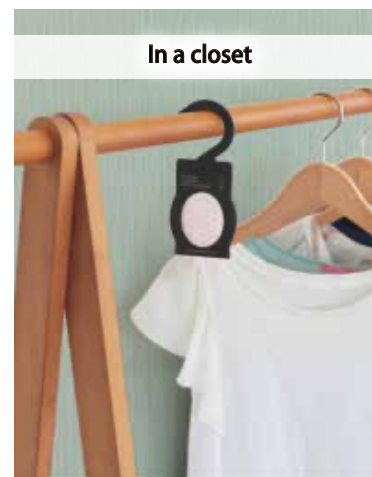
Remove the lid and place Miyako Ash (P.26) in to the incense censer.
Light the tip of the incense and fan out of the fire flame.
Insert the stick incense in to the ash or place coil/cone incense on the ash.

* We recommend removing the lid while burning incense. In many cases the lid will restrict the flow of oxygen and can extinguish the incense.

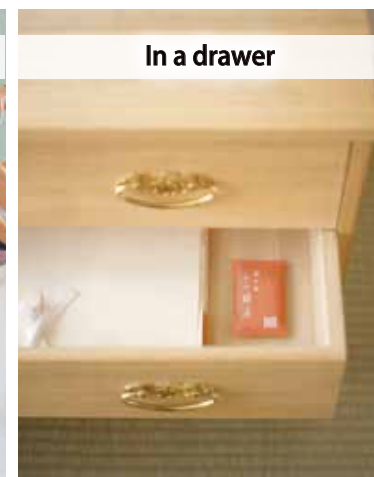
Sachets are Non-burning incense items which release a fragrance in its natural, unheated state.

Historically, Japanese fragrant sachets have consisted of a plain or brocade cloth bag with "Nioi-koh" - a powdered mix of natural ingredients such as clove, camphor and sandalwood - inside.

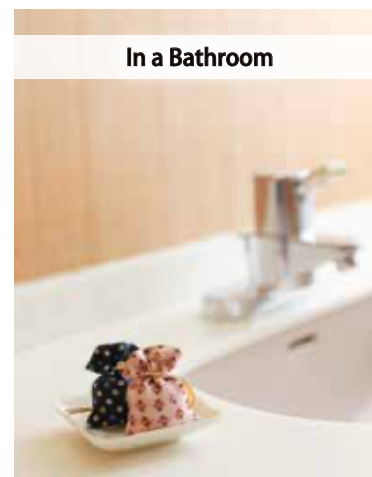
